## Year 4 Autumn Term 1

### English

We are starting this term with the story of King Arthur to link in with our Saxons and Vikings history curriculum.

Next is a non-fiction report connected to Anglo-Saxons and their invasion of England, why they came and why they stayed.

Finally, we are looking at similes through poetry

### Science, Wider Curriculum

Science—This term is Forces & Magnets. Looking at the different types of force we experience and use every day and how and why magnets work and what they are used for.

History - This term we are discovering all about Saxons and Vikings, why they came, what they were like and how they influenced life in England.

Art - Anglo-Saxon and Viking drawings and patterns

D&T—We will be making shields, houses and boats

Geography - We will be doing map work linked to our Saxons and Vikings topic

### Maths

Reasoning and understanding of number is our first objective this term, following our new Mathematics programme of study. We will then go on to written methods of calculating for the four rules; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

### RE

This term we are researching and learning about important and influential people of the 20th century. The effects they have on our society and the way we live.

### PE

This term the PE team are concentrating on Football and basketball, teaching the skills and rules needed to play games and work well in teams.

### Homework

Maths homework will be set weekly.  
Children are expected to read for 10 minutes every day.  
Spellings will be sent weekly.  
Each child will be given a book with assignments to choose from, they pick one assignment each week.
