

Report of the Allocation of Sports premium Funding 2015-16

Background

The Sports Premium is a funding strategy to support primary schools in promoting sport and health. PE and sport is a key priority within Hartley Brook and the funding is used to provide excellent provision for our pupils. We are proud of our achievements in this field. Each year we receive approximately £11000 dependant upon our pupils numbers and we spend this money as detailed below.

Payment dates

Academies receive the funding in 2 separate payments one in November and one in May.

How to use the premium

The premium should be used to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport offered, including improvements which will benefit pupils joining the school in future years. Some examples are introducing new sports and activities, running sports competitions and supporting after school and holiday clubs.

What we are doing

At the end of the 2014/15 school year we recruited a part time PE teacher to work closely with our existing sports coach. A full audit of the curriculum, facilities and equipment was undertaken and this identified current provision and where developments were required. They then put together a full, inclusive, curriculum which meets the national requirement. A format was put in place to record activities which children took part in and how they were progressing. Children were identified who were lacking in certain skills and a plan was put in place to accelerate their progress. Also, children with specific talents were identified and encouraged to pursue their sport strength. This is monitored weekly.

Morning and lunch time clubs were introduced, including Football for both boys and girls. We are also part of the Sheffield Federation of school sports and take part in leagues and competitions with other schools and we took part in the Sheffield finals. Hartley Brook has improved to the extent that we now regularly get to the finals and often win competitions.

After school clubs have been established every Tuesday alongside all the other clubs we have on this day. Over 2 thirds of our children take part in these clubs and is open to all year groups. Additional support has been identified for areas which are different from the curriculum and external professional coaching is taking place.

Our PE staff have coached our existing staff to enable them to take part in lessons whenever needed. Pupils take part in Sports FX at Firth Park Academy. We have also obtained Sainsbury's Schools Games Mark status (Silver Award) for participation in after school activities, competitions and children in sports leadership roles.

Our sports experience for pupils has been given a much higher profile this year, with evidence recording on IPAD's and a Twitter account has been set up to report what we are doing to our

parents and community. We are fast becoming recognised as a centre of excellence for PE and sport.
