Dear Parent / Carer,

As we progress with our plans to improve reading throughout school, we have teamed up with Firth Park Library to provide children with opportunities to visit the library (in school time) to borrow books.

Membership is completely free. All you need to do is complete and return the attached library card application form if your child is not already a member. We are asking for these **to be returned to your child's class teacher by Friday 29th March** so that the library can prepare the children's membership cards before they visit.

We will be making our visit to the library (during school time) **on Wednesday 17th April**. Children will be able to borrow a book. You will then be able to return the book, with your child, and borrow more books.

As we have your signed permission for local walks, we **do not require** a signed consent form to complete the library visits. If you would prefer your child not take part, please inform your child's class teacher.

If you would like to take your child to any other library in Sheffield, including Southey Green and Parson Cross, this card will allow them to do this and the books can be returned to any library. Children can borrow up to fifteen books at a time and the loan period is three weeks.

We hope that you will encourage your child to take part in this exciting opportunity and complete the form by **Friday 29th March**.
