

Attendance Updates:

Please be reminded that if your child is classed as a persistently absence pupil, with an attendance percentage of 90% and below, school will no longer be authorising any further absence. This is in line with the expectations set for schools by the Local Authority. For appointments – where evidence can be provided, this will be authorised. A child with an attendance percentage of 90% at this point in the school year has already been absent for 28 sessions (14 school days).

If you need extra support or are facing any barriers in getting your child to school please speak with the inclusion team, we are here to help!
